Also note- The weed Mercury, the California listed noxious weed *Mercurialis ambigua* from 2016-2017 has spread up and down the San Mateo County Coast on either side of Highway One and rapidly invading cultivated fields and forming solid stands within a few hundred feet of the highway roadsides. Poisonous to livestock, Spurge family.
