Woodside has two basic soil types, the serpentine on Kite Hill and next to Barkley Field, and the sandstone that is everywhere else.

Then the grasses divide into wet and dry and sun and shade. I will give you a list of seeds ecotypes and their source locations.

SHADE DRY SANDSTONE:

- -- California brome (Tina's) harvested 6/8
- --(future) Blue Wild Rye "shade" ecotype (Tina's) still green will be ready in July

SUN DRY SANDSTONE

- --Blue eyed grass (Araradero) harvested in 2015, 2016
- --Blue Wild Rye "sun" ecotype (Tina's) harvested 6/8
- --California poppy (Aratsradero) harvested 2015, maybe 2016 crop
- --(future) Heterotheca (Canada Road) ripe Sept.
- --Short Brome (Tina's) harvested 6/8
- --(future) Spanish clover (Village Hill and Tina's) ripe Aug-Sept.
- --(future) Tarweed (Canada Road) ripe Sept.-Oct.

SUN DRY SERPENTINE -- Kite Hill

- --Blue Eyed Grass harvested May
- --Vulpia grass harvested May
- --(future) California poppy -- Ripe July
